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Dr. Fovelle is currently a postdoctoral researcher at the Institute of Mathematics (IMAG) in the Universidad de Granada (Spain). Prior to that, she was a research visitor at Texas A&M University (USA) and at LmB, Besançon (France). Dr. Fovelle earned her Ph.D. at the Université de Franche-Comté, Besançon (France) in 2023 under the supervision of Prof. Gilles Lancien. She has delivered several lectures at a great variety of scientific seminaries, workshops, congresses and conferences on both research and recreational mathematics.

Dr. Fovelle's areas of research includes a variety of topics in Functional Analysis (and, more particularly, Banach space theory) such as linear and nonlinear aspects in asymptotic geometry of Banach spaces, Hamming graphs, and norm-attaining functionals.
